*Lions (R1) are task-orientated extroverts.*

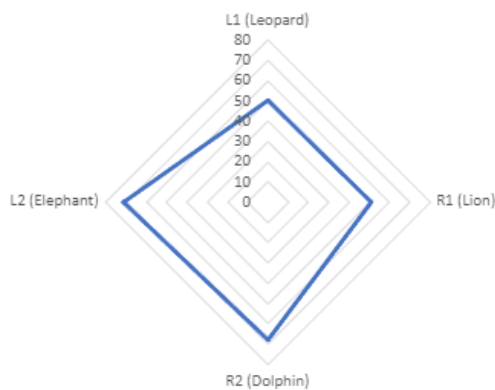
*Dolphins (R2) are people-orientated extroverts.*
