In my current role (last 7 years) I am invested in supporting the transition of students with learning disabilities into meaningful vocational pathways, I am committed to developing innovative pre-vocational programs that empower students to build essential skills, foster independence, and achieve their full potential in the workforce. I strive to create inclusive learning opportunities that prepare students for successful transitions to adulthood. Moreover, my work with students suffering from mental health diagnoses has equipped me with the knowledge and skills to support students' emotional well-being, develop coping strategies, and promote resilience in the face of adversity.

Working 3 years (2003-2006) with visually impaired students, I gained experience in assistive technology, and environmental modifications to promote accessibility and facilitate learning. I work closely with educators, families, and interdisciplinary teams to develop comprehensive intervention plans and create supportive environments that nurture students' growth and development. Working 3 years in impoverished communities created a strong belief in the power of community-based approaches to address the multifaceted needs of individuals living with disabilities. I strived to empower community rehabilitation workers and foster sustainable solutions that enhanced the well-being of individuals with disabilities.

Temperament Typology


Temperament refers to a person's inborn qualities. This assessment measures extraversion on one axis and task or people orientation on the other.

Leopards (L1) are task-orientated introverts.
Lions (R1) are task-orientated extroverts.
Dolphins (R2) are people-orientated extroverts.
Elephants (L2) are people-orientated introverts.
